Top Resume Tips from L3Harris Panelists



1

Write a list of your accomplishments in the military and highlight those achievements that relate to the role you are applying to.
Having multiple resumes for different roles is better than having one general resume.
You want to make sure you stand out.



2

Spotlight all your transferable skills:
Leadership, Teamwork, Training, Communications, Problem Solving.
If you see it in the job description be sure to highlight those skills on your resume.



3

Pick the right Format:
1-2 pages
A brief summary of your experience.
A list of your technical skills & Education & Training.
Chronological layout -> begin with your most recent job and go from there.
If you have a security clearance, please add this to your resume.
