Joseph

Two things you should have on your resume:

- First, add your full name, including the city and state. It is also always great to add if you are open to relocation.
- Secondly, clearly list the companies and the job titles you have done over the years. Be sure to look at the job description and highlight similar tasks you have held while in the military.

Jessie

Veterans stick out immediately while applying to G&W. Being coachable will help you. It's important to highlight if you worked in the following:

- Outdoors
- In a safety-sensitive environment
- Around the clock in different elements
